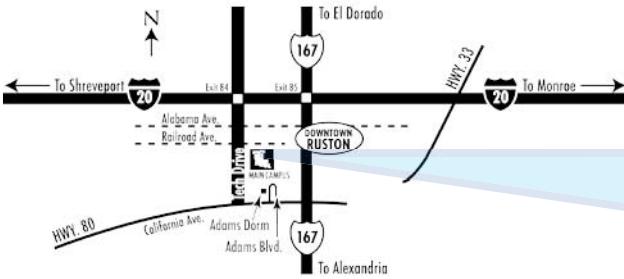

Wyly Tower parking lot near the Student Center

From the north: Take Highway 167 South to I-20 West, exit 84. At the top of the exit ramp, turn left onto Tech Drive. Follow Tech Drive to campus. Turn left onto Railroad Avenue.\*

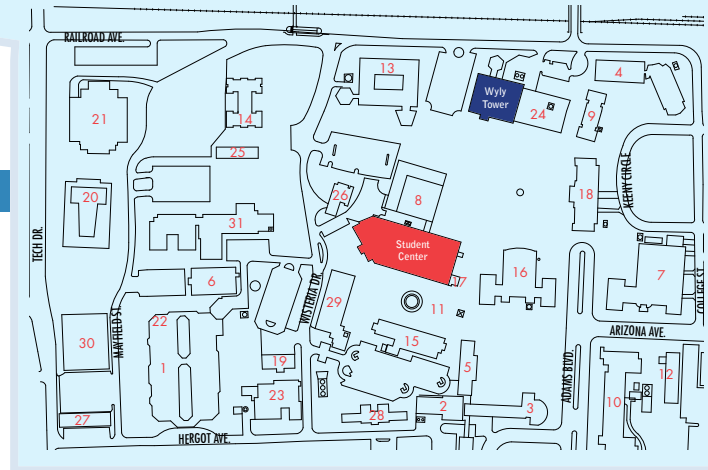
From the south: Take Highway 167 North to Ruston. Turn left onto Arizona Avenue. Turn right onto College Street. College Street becomes Railroad Avenue. Turn right.\*

From the east: Take I-20 West to Ruston, exit 84. At the top of the exit ramp, turn left onto Tech Drive. Follow Tech Drive to campus. Turn left onto Railroad Avenue.\*

From the west: Take I-20 East to Ruston, exit 84. At the top of the exit ramp, turn right onto Tech Drive. Follow Tech Drive to campus. Turn left onto Railroad Avenue. \*

\* Follow Railroad Avenue to Wyly Tower of Learning (16-story white building). The lot in front of Wyly Tower is near the Student Center. Park in the Wyly Tower lot and proceed south to the "Quad," the heart of campus. Wyly Tower anchors the north end of the Quad and the Student Center is at the south end.

**TIP!** Keep a copy of your ACT/SAT scores and your high school transcript, and/or transcripts from any college that you may have received credit (ie: dual enrollment) with you at orientation to show your academic advisor.
