Kurzweil 3000 Version 12 is an integrated literacy software that supports reading, writing, study skills, research, test-taking and more. Kurzweil can read aloud virtually any text, giving struggling readers independent access to reading materials, whether they're in print, in digital format, or on the Web. Because it's content-independent, this powerful tool can be used with any age level and any reading materials. Kurzweil 3000 is being used in most school districts in Louisiana, many charter and private schools and in some community colleges and universities. It is research based and supports Universal Design for Learning, differentiated instruction, and can be used by individuals, small groups, and for whole class instruction. This session will provide participants with an overview of Kurzweil 300 software.
