4.	Pass the appropriate PRAXIS II Secondary Education: Content Knowledge (____) specialty examination. If seeking English certification, there are two exams .
5.	Present acceptable GRE scores.

7.	Submit your resume.
8.	Submit three letters of recommendation.
9.	Complete and submit a Professional Conduct Form.
10.	Complete a graduate application and submit to Graduate School with \$40.00 application fee.
