4.	Pass the Elementary Education: Content Knowledge (0014) PRAXIS II specialty examination.
5.	Present GRE scores, which equal or exceed 1300 (cumulative UGPA x 200 + GREV + GREQ)
6.	Develop and submit your teaching philosophy. See http://latech.edu/education/index.php?id=410 for more information.
7.	Submit your resume.
8.	Submit three letters of recommendation.
9.	Complete and submit a Professional Conduct Form.
10.	Complete a graduate application and submit to Graduate School with \$40.00 application fee.
