- a. Acceptable **GRE** scores and approved **Plan of Study** required during 1<sup>st</sup> quarter enrolled.
- b. **Minimum GGPA of 3.0 must be maintained throughout the entire program.** No more than two (2) Cs are permitted in the program.
- c. **Substitution courses and transfer courses** must receive prior approval before enrolling in the class.
- d. Candidates beginning the M.S. program during Fall Quarter 2008 and thereafter are required to successfully complete an electronic portfolio and submit it for evaluation via the *TaskStream* web-based toolset and assessment system prior to program completion. The e-portfolio must be submitted no later than the fourth week of the quarter of expected graduation, but may be submitted by the fourth week of the quarter immediately prior to the quarter of expected graduation. Students enrolled in the M.S. programs prior to Fall Quarter 2008 have the option of either successfully completing a comprehensive examination or the e-portfolio (only one option may be selected).
