- 1,562 FORCIBLE RAPES WERE REPORTED IN LOUISIANA IN 2006.
- IN 2005, LOUISIANA HAD THE THIRD HIGHEST NUMBER OF FEMALES MURDERED BY MALES IN THE NATION.
- FOUR CHILDREN DIE EVERY DAY IN THE U.S. AS A RESULT OF CHILD ABUSE AND 3 OUT OF 4 OF THESE CHILDREN ARE UNDER THE AGE OF 4.
