DOES IT COST EXTRA?

There are no additional housing costs or fees related to participation. The following is a list of possible options for housing should you agree to be a part of this exciting opportunity!

Regular Residence Hall \$860.00
(Double Occupancy) per quarter

University Park Apartments \$1420.00
Apartment Style living per quarter
(2 and 4 person) 9 month lease

WHAT IS A LIVING-LEARNING COMMUNITY?



The Columns that mark the original entrance into the University.

Living-Learning Communities are residentially based programs that link academic programs and residential life through a common theme. These communities take learning outside of the classroom and into the residence hall. It promotes connections through intentional programming and academic resources. Peer mentors (upperclassmen) participate in the community through assistance with courses and hosting social events to assist peers in getting to know one another.

DO I QUALIFY?

As a member of the freshman class living on campus, you are automatically a member of the First-Year Experience (FYE) at Louisiana Tech. However, some courses have specific requirements, see (*) SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS on next page. Let us know you are interested and we will do the rest!

WHAT WOULD I GAIN FROM THE EXPERIENCE?

The FYE program gives you a chance to get to know the campus, your professors, and your fellow neighbors. Being a part of the LLC offers unique programming and resources to help you transition to college life and become part of the Tech Family!

INTERESTED AND WONDERING WHAT TO DO NEXT?

The academic component requires that a student in the FYE Living-Learning Community register for a linkage of two courses. ***SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS APPLY:** Students whose reading ACT was less than or equal to 17 or Verbal + Math SAT less than or equal to 850 MUST take UNIV 101 and are therefore not eligible for this LLC
