

Dear Parent/Guardian,

We know that your child is excited about living in the dorm here at Louisiana Tech University. There are a few things that you may need to know about the dorms. **You will need to bring along a mattress cover, sheets, a pillow, pillowcase, comforter, etc. for a twin size bed.** Please bring an alarm clock so that you will be on time for morning classes. There are phone jacks in every dorm room, but no phones. You may bring a phone to use in order to receive incoming calls, but will not be able to dial long distance. You can, however, use a calling card to dial long distance. Each camper will be assigned a phone number at check in on the first day of camp. Cell phones are permitted, but **must be turned off during classes.** You may want your child to bring a light jacket or sweater with them in case classrooms are cool.

Some things are prohibited from the dorm. For example, burning candles is not allowed for safety reasons. All other items listed on the "What not to bring to the dorm" flyer are to ensure your child's safety while staying here at Louisiana Tech University.
