Step 1. Click on web site, <http://www.ncdc.noaa.gov/oa/ncdc.html>

Step 2. Click on the data and products hyperlink (left side of the web site).

Step 3. Select data from a list of “Most Popular Products”; choose Climatological Data (CD). This data includes the Tech Station.

Step 4. Select a state from the “Climatological Data Publications”, choose Louisiana, and click on Next.

Step 5. Select a date, and click on Next, click on the data contained in a PDF file. Data for Louisiana in this table begins January, 1888 for select cities in Louisiana. Data for the Ruston La Tech station begins in 1946.
