WHO CAN ATTEND?

The clinic is for any dancers in grades 7-12 who are interested in learning fun dance routines! This clinic will also help any dancer interested in trying out for the Regal Blues by showing you the technical skills required at try-outs.

WHAT WILL YOU LEARN?

You will spend the day with the Regal Blues and they will teach you routines incorporating hip hop and jazz. There will be technique classes divided by level: beginner, intermediate, and advanced. There will also be a technique section designed just for girls interested in trying out for a college dance team, specifically the Regal Blues! Also, you will learn a routine to perform that night at the showcase with the Regal Blues!!

WHAT IS THE DAY LIKE?

9:30am- check-in (**wear anything comfortable to dance in**)

10:00am- clinic starts (During the morning hours, dance routines will be taught in different groups)

11:30-12:30pm- lunch (You will need to bring a bag lunch or money for local fast food)

12:30-1:30pm- technique class/review of dance taught from the morning

1:30-4:45pm- break (This will be your time to freshen up and get ready for the showcase. For the showcase you may wear anything you want to perform in. Please have hair and make-up performance ready)

4:45pm- meet at Howard Auditorium for the showcase! (You will perform at the show and then watch the Regal Blues perform)

5:00pm- Showcase begins

The clinic will be held at Lambright Intramural Center(meet us here at 9:30am). The Showcase will be held at Howard Auditorium on Louisiana Tech’s Campus. (Directions will be given at the Clinic in the morning.)

The cost for the clinic is \$30 per dancer. This includes dance instruction, a 2011-2012 Regal Blues t-shirt, and a ticket to the Showcase. Additional showcase tickets can be purchased at the door for \$3.
