

Assistant Professor(s) in Architectural Design

The School of Architecture is seeking candidates to fill a tenure-track teaching position or positions at the assistant professor level beginning 1 September 2012. The primary teaching responsibilities will include instruction in upper level design studios as well as supporting courses in one of the following areas: urban design, theory, digital fabrication, architectural detailing, professional practice, or ethics. Additional responsibilities will include serving on various School, College, and University committees. Candidates must have a terminal degree with a professional degree in architecture and demonstrate the potential for executing an agenda of research and/or creative work. Previous teaching and professional practice experience are required and professional licensure is desirable.
