Resolution Proposing an

Amendment to the University Senate Constitution

1	Section 1. Be it Resolved by the Senate of Louisiana Tech University, by two-thirds of the
2	Senate concurring, that there shall be submitted to the faculty and staff of the University and the
3	University President for their approval or rejection in the manner provided in Article VI of the
4	Senate Constitution, the following proposed Amendments to the Senate Constitution:
5	
6	Article II, Section 2, Paragraph 3 to read as follows:
7	
8	3. Terms of Office:
9	Each University Senate member will be elected for a term of three years or to complete an
10	unexpired term. A University Senate representative may not be elected to succeed
11	himself/herself unless completing a term of two years or less.
12	A University Senate member serving as President or Vice President (President Elect) may
13	continue to serve beyond his/her original term of office; both of these offices are non-voting
14	positions.
15	When a Senator assumes the office of Vice President (President Elect) or President, his/her
16	constituent unit will declare a vacancy and must select a new voting Senator if any unexpired
17	portion of a term exists.

1 Article III, Sections 1 through 2 to read as follows:

Section 1. Officers and Election:

The officers of the University Senate shall be Past-President (non-voting), President (non-4 5 voting), Vice President (non-voting), Parliamentarian, and Treasurer. All offices are subject to a 6 one-year-term. Elections shall be held at the last University Senate meeting of each spring for all officers except Past-President with such terms of office to be effective July 1st. Any current 7 member of the Executive Committee, or any past member of the Executive Committee who is 8 9 currently serving as a Senator, may be a candidate to the Offices of President or Vice President. Any Senate member may be a candidate to the Offices of Vice President, Parliamentarian or 10 Treasurer. and President; the present Vice President will accede to the office of President. The 11 terms of office to be effective July 1 shall be as follows: The Past President, President and Vice 12 President, one year only; all others may succeed themselves to the extent that their elected 13 University Senate terms allow. The President and Vice President may be re-elected to 14 15 subsequent one-year-terms of office, up to twice, for a total maximum of three consecutive terms per office. Upon completion of a third consecutive term, the Any person vacating the office of 16 17 President may not be a candidate for the office of President or Vice President for the next three elections. Upon completion of a third consecutive term, the Any person vacating the office of 18 Vice President may not be a candidate for the office of Vice President for the next three elections 19 20 but may be a candidate for President. The Parliamentarian and Treasurer may be re-elected to subsequent one-year-terms of office to the extent their elected University Senate terms allow. 21 Upon the election of a new President, the Office of Past-President shall be filled by the out-going 22

President and shall serve as Past-President for one term only.

Section 2. Duties:

- 3 The duties of the officers noted in Section 1 above will be those that normally pertain to the
- 4 office held; the University Senate will arrange for competent secretarial assistance to fulfill the
- 5 duties of Secretary. The University Senate Past-President will provide advice and assistance in
- 6 the continuity of the jobs of President and Vice President; the University Senate President may
- 7 appoint committees as he/she deems necessary to conduct the business of the University Senate;
- 8 the Vice President shall perform those duties assigned by the President and shall become
- 9 prepared to assume the duties of President the following year.

- 11 **Section II.** Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment shall be submitted to the faculty
- and staff of the University by written electronic ballot on [insert date] with such ballots required
- 13 to be returned concluded and recorded byto the Secretary no later than [ten days later]. If the
- amendment receives a two-thirds vote by ballot of the faculty and staff voting thereon, it shall be
- submitted to the University President for his approval or rejection.
- **Section III.** Be it further resolved that should this proposed amendment be adopted, the current
- 17 Constitution as written shall sunset as follows: The currently serving Vice President (President-
- 18 Elect) shall serve a term as President commencing July 1, 2015. The currently serving President
- 19 | shall serve a term as Past-President commencing July 1, 2015. At Prior to the last University
- 20 Senate meeting in Spring Quarter May of 2015, when elections are normally held, the following
- 21 offices will be voted uponelectronic balloting will be held for the offices of: Vice President,
- Parliamentarian, and Treasurer. The officers so elected shall be subject to the provision of this
- amendment. At the last University Senate meeting in Spring Quarter of 2016, this amendment

1	shall be fully implemented and all offices shall be voted upon in accordance to the provisions
2	proposed herein.
