## Preparatory Coursework Certification 2022-2023

**Definition of Preparatory Coursework (34 CFR685.203(a)(6))**: Preparatory coursework refers to courses a student is required to take in order to be admitted into a regular degree program. The courses are preparatory to the degree, not a part of the degree requirements. At Louisiana Tech University, these students may be classified as Post Baccalaureate Undergraduate (PBUG) if they are seeking entry into a Master's program.

### Example of preparatory coursework:

Eddy has a bachelor's degree. He wants to enroll in a graduate program, but cannot be unconditionally admitted to the program. Graduate students must be unconditionally admitted to the graduate program to be eligible for graduate level loans. However, because he still requires 12 hours of undergraduate coursework to meet the graduate program's unconditional admission requirements, he may receive undergraduate level loans for this coursework if he has not already borrowed the lifetime maximum undergraduate loan limit and has not received loan funds for preparatory courses in the past.

**Note:** To be eligible the student must be taking classes that are a prerequisite for admission. If he is only taking them to raise his GPA in order to be admitted, he would not qualify for loans.
