Mission

The Threat Assessment Team (TAT) supports the mission of the University in providing a challenging yet safe and supportive environment to enrich the development of students. The TAT works collaboratively with campus resources to promote student health and well-being.

Purpose

The purpose of the TAT is to serve as a central network and clearinghouse for identification and early intervention of students exhibiting indications of extreme distress or those engaging in harmful or disruptive behaviors. The Team will meet monthly and thereafter as needed to discuss potential threats to the safety of the University community, identify students exhibiting threats to safety, and recommend strategies for response in accordance with existing University policy.
