Dear University Senate Committee,

It is my honor and pleasure to be nominated for the 2023-2024 Outstanding Service Award as it reflects my love and passion for Louisiana Tech University.

I began working in the admissions office as a temporary employee in 2006, inputting applications for prospective students. It didn't take me long to realize Louisiana Tech University was where I wanted to complete my career. In 2007, I became a full-time employee as an Administrative Coordinator 3 (Freshman Admissions Processor). I am currently an Administrative Coordinator 4. My daily priority is processing first-time Freshman Applications. I process over 8,000 Freshman applicants per year. I obtain documents to process applications such as importing of test scores, STS for in-state students and paper transcripts for home school and out of state students. Home School and out of state student transcripts are calculated manually. In addition to first time freshman, I process visiting students which includes the Adult Fitness Program, Cross-town agreement and ICP applicants. I also help with dual enrollment application errors. While my job can become time consuming, I enjoy the vast responsibilities expected of me.

During the prime months of Admissions, I work many evenings and weekends to ensure students are processed in a timely manner. In the middle of May, we start receiving final transcripts for the class of 2024. Each student's transcript is reviewed for final data and a graduation date which can be a lengthy process especially for out of state and home school students. We start admitting Freshman for the following year on July 15 so it is a continuous process. I am someone who is willing to work outside the office to ensure the success of the students.

Through the years I have had the privilege to build relationships with students and other departments in the university. I strive to do my best to serve others and this university. The most important thing is for me to be a team player and always wear a Tech smile. My position allows me to participate in new unique experiences and learning opportunities. Throughout the years, I have had the opportunity to grow and change with the new processes. From implementing Slate to now working in Workday, the challenges and excitement of new processes continue to happen.

I enjoy meeting new faces of prospective students and their families. My favorite part of my job is sharing the joy of Louisiana Tech with incoming freshman and their families whether it be through helping them with admittance, time out for Tech or working alongside them as student workers.




Office but have also positively impacted the overall educational experience for our students.
