Don't include any social security benefits unless (a) you are married filing a separate return and you lived with your spouse at any time during 2024 or (b) one-half of your social security benefits plus your other gross income and any tax-exempt interest is more than \$25,000 (\$32,000 if married filing jointly). If (a) or (b) applies, see the form 1040 and 1040-SR or Publication 915 to figure the taxable part of social security benefits you must include in gross income. Gross income includes gains, but not losses, reported on Form 8949 or Schedule D. Gross income from a business means, for example, the amount on Schedule C, Line 7, or Schedule F, Line 9.
