Don't include any social security benefits unless (a) you are married filing a separate return and you lived with your spouse at any time during 2022 or (b) one-half of your social security benefits plus your other gross income and any tax-exempt interest is more than \$25,000 (\$32,000 if married filing jointly). If (a) or (b) applies, see the form 1040 and 1040-SR or Publication 915 to figure the taxable part of social security benefits you must include in gross income.
